An invitation to join the RCHA Club in 2011

Date of joining	Dues
Between December 1, 2010 – March 15, 2011	\$100
Between March 15 – May 31, 2011	\$ 75
Between May 31 – August 15, 2011	\$ 50
Between August 15 – October 31, 2011	\$ 25

All new applications are reviewed by the Board of Directors, and, following approval, dues may be paid by cash, cheque, debit or credit card via the Bar Steward who will issue you with a receipt and a membership card. Full year dues may be paid in 2 instalments: \$50 on approval and a post dated cheque for \$50 dated by May 31, 2011.

Please submit your application via the Bar Staff or mail it to the above address (attention Membership Chair). You may also scan and send it by email to the undersigned.

Gunners & Ex-gunners of the Royal Canadian Artillery may join as Active Members immediately; others are Associates and after two years (24 months), are encouraged to apply for Active Membership by completing the application form available at the Club. Non-RCA Military persons may apply to be an Active member after 1 year (12 months). Active members may vote at meetings and hold office.

Associates may attend & speak at meetings but may not vote or hold office until accepted as an Active Member.

Associates & Members are not subject to entertainment charges and receive a discount for some special events. As well, through volunteering in the club, participating in the events, and your annual dues, you are contributing to the sustainability and future of the Club. Everyone is expected to support the goals and objectives of the RCHABA .
